Ally Network Conference 2018 - Student Bursary Terms and Conditions

The Ally Network Conference 2018 will award the following bursary to student candidates to assist attendance at the Australian Ally Network Conference 2018 only.

Applications will be required to be submitted by the early bird registration deadline of the 31st July 2018.

Funding

- The bursary is valued at the cost of the registration per applicant;
- The amount will cover one or two days attendance, depending on the applicant's availability to attend each day, ie. \$90 to attend one day or \$120 for an early bird registration fee.

Eligibility

This scheme is open to student presenter candidates only. Interested applicants who have already submitted abstracts to the conference and/or paid their registration can still apply. If successful the registration fee will be refunded.

Terms and conditions

Up to **four** bursaries are available for the 2018 conference. It is a competitive application, and the Conference Committee will assess all applications for suitability.

Successful applicants are required to:

• Attend and present a paper at the conference.

Applications

Applicants should complete the application form and send it as an email attachment to <u>AllyConference2018@curtin.edu.au</u>, using the subject line **Student Bursary Application**. If your abstract is accepted for the conference it will then be forwarded to the Conference Committee for consideration of the bursary application.

The closing date for applications of the bursary is by the early bird registration deadline being the 31st of July 2018. Late applications will generally **not** be accepted.

All applications for the bursary will be acknowledged by email, and all applicants will be notified of the outcome of their application by email. The decision of the Conference Committee will be final and no correspondence will be entered into or feedback given.
