Zulkiflee Anwar Haque, better known as Zunar to Malaysians, is a cartoonist and satirist who has been entertaining and informing Malaysians about their world for over 20 years.

In his first Australian tour, the multi award-winning cartoonist will be drawing, discussing and performing on Malaysian politics, its current billion-dollar corruption crisis, art and censorship across five cities.

Zunar is facing 43 years in prison on 9 charges of 'sedition' over his outspoken criticism – using satire and cartoons – of Malaysia's Najib government. Zunar's five cartoon books are banned in Malaysia for allegedly carrying content "detrimental to public order" and the police have confiscated thousands of copies.

Zunar's fight for the freedom of expression in Malaysia was recognised with the CPJ's Press Freedom Award 2015, the Hellman-Hammett Award from Human Rights Watch and most recently, the Cartooning for Peace Award 2016 along with a public installation of his work along Lake Geneva, launched by the city's mayor and former UN Secretary-General Kofi Annan.
